ESCA Election Process

October is the start of the **ESCA** election process, with the appointment of a three-person **nomination committee** at the **first meeting in October**.

The nomination committee will call or email eligible members to obtain permission to put them on the slate for nomination to the Board.

The nomination committee will present their slate to the membership at the first meeting in November and then additional nominations can be presented at regular meetings.

To be eligible to run for an elective office, a person must be a Regular Active Member, and have been in the club for over 6 months. The minimum age for an elective officer is eighteen.

If you have never been an elected Officer and would like to find out what it is all about, please call or talk to any current Officer.

Serving on the Board is a great way to get more involved in **ESCA** and help out your club. (Contact the **ESCA Secretary** if you need to know your membership status.)

* Things Self-Tech Inspector Should Looks at *

- ► Empty all loose items from your Car, inc. the Trunk
- ► Remove wheel covers or Hub Caps
- ► Helmet must be Snell Approved 2010 or newer.
- ► (Snell 2000 & 2005 are not allowed)
- ► Safety equipment is installed correctly and does not have any excess movement
- ➤ Seat Belts present & secure: Two-strap shoulder harnesses shall not be worn in open automobiles, which are not equipped with roll bars.
- ➤ Roll bars are REQUIRED in all purpose-built competition cars and any
- ► other open cockpit AUTOMOBILES using racing (non-D.O.T. approved) tires
- ► Tight steering wheel
- ► Firm brake pedal
- ► No side-to-side Wheel bearing movement
- ► Lug Nuts all are present and tight
- ➤ Tires, have good tread depth with no bulges, cuts or cords
- ► Ensure the battery is properly tied down
- ► Engine and all other fluid caps are present and secure
- ► Engine hoses, wires, and belts are in good shape and free of cracks. Numbers are in place and meet specifications

Autocross Helmet Requirement

Autocross helmets MUST be Snell Approved 2010 or Newer for all events.



Ten Years Ago in Pit Stop October 2014

On the front page was an article about a tour to Pt. Reyes and information about an October18th autocross at the airport and an end of the autocross season pizza party.

Inside a Fast Times article by the **ESCA** Chairman talked about a September, Saturday and Sunday autocross, Chaired by Art Battles and Brooke Stephens, which had a small turn-out on both days. He also said some classes would come down to the last event to decided the class winner. He stated the end of the year would be very busy with an October Tour and Autocross, a November Rallye, and the December banquet.

There was an Officers Nomination article about looking for the nomination committee.

An **ESCA** Charity Rallye article stated the start would be from the St. Francis Shopping Center, with a finish at Round Table Pizza in Montecito Center. It was a non-competition A-B type rallye with a course time of about 1 and a half hours.

An article entitled Looking Back by Marci Jenkins was about a three-day event on Labor Day Weekend, put on by the Northern Sports Car Council called the Sports Car Olympics which started in 1961 at Squaw Valley and ended in 1996 at Boreal Ridge. Some **ESCA** member ran many of the years and put on events and even chaired the entire event.

In a Sunday Autocross article also by Brooke Stephens listed first in class GTA-R Mark

Mervich, GTB-R Jim Winston, GTC-R Duke Schimmer, GTA-S Tom Buggia GTB-S Cody Farrell, GTC-S Donnie Bamberg and had 37 drivers.

- ▶ Drive slowly and quietly to and from site


