John joined ESCA in 1966, dropped out, and then rejoined ESCA. He is a current member living in Washington state. We sometimes see him when he visits Santa Rosa to see his daughter. In 1967 he drove an MGB and he is also a pilot.

In 1968 John showed up at an ESCA autocross at the old Naval Air Station in a *Cessna Cherokee 140* and thought he'd try to register for the event. He was told he could not enter the autocross as the event chair thought his propeller was too dangerous.

on their Snell dates. Additionally we will be following SCCA windshield rules for drivers of any vehicle without a DOT-approved windshield (such as kit cars) or any other vehicle with less than standard-sized windshield, helmets must be full face and a shield, preferably made of impact-resistant materials, shall be used while on course (conventional eyeglasses are not sufficient). For more info on SCCA rules and regulations visit www.scca.com/pages/solo-cars-and-rules.

Tire reminder..... 200 tread wear and above are street tires class (S) and anything below are race class (R) we will be tracking this more closely this year.

We will continue *self tech* but if you have any questions regarding safety or classification of your car we have a lot of very experienced club members, as well as, myself who will be more than happy to help.

We may have a new *one day membership program* this year. This program will allow more people to come out and give autocrossing a try. For more information on this program check the web site or send us an email.

The Word on Helmets for this Year!

For the helmets: This year will be the last year for accepting **SNELL SA/M 2010**. This is following what SCCA is doing. New 2025 certified helmets will not be available until Q3 this year, so I think it is safe to say that folks should upgrade their helmets this year.

We WILL need to check next year when 2015 or newer helmets are required to insure that all helmets are in compliance.

Helmets:

➤ Snell SA2020, SA2015, SA2010, SAH2010

This does appear to be the last year for 2010 (SCCA).

For drivers of any vehicle without a DOT-approved windshield (such as kit cars) or any other vehicle with less than standard-sized windshield, **helmets** must be full face and a shield, preferably made of impact-resistant materials, shall be used while on course (conventional eyeglasses are not sufficient).

As we do have some open face loaner helmets we should be aware of this as well when we hand out loaners and enforce this when applicable .

I am working on an article that will reinforce some of these points as well
